SNAP exam pattern 2025 has 60 questions, divided into these three sections, to be solved in 60 minutes. SNAP 2024 Exam will be held on December 8, 15 and 21, 2024. 1. Overview of SNAP Exam Pattern and Syllabus 2024

SNAP exam 2024 is of shorter duration and is of one hour duration. The exam has 60 questions with maximum 60 marks. SNAP exam 2024 is being conducted on three different dates in December 2024. SNAP 2024 exam syllabus for all the three SNAP exams is same. SNAP Syllabus 2024 covers the sectional test composition, number of questions, type of questions, important topics, scoring pattern in SNAP Test. 2. Overview of SNAP Syllabus 2024

SNAP Syllabus 2024 is divided into three major sections on English, Quant and Reasoning. Different number of questions appear in each section of SNAP exam. Below is shared the overall SNAP syllabus 2024:
