XAT exam pattern is designed to assess a candidate's decision-making/ analytical-thinking, language skills, quantitative aptitude, and general knowledge. The XAT 2026 exam pattern comprises a total of 95 questions spread across four key sections. These include Decision Making (21 questions), Verbal and Logical Ability (26 questions), Quantitative Ability and Data Interpretation (28 questions), and General Knowledge (20 questions). Each question carries one mark, making the total to 95 marks. Check details in table below.

- **Verbal Ability and Logical Reasoning:** Reading Comprehension, Vocabulary, Analogy, Parajumble, Grammar, Critical Reasoning, Fill in the Blanks, etc.
- **Decision Making:** Data Arrangement, Conditioning, Grouping, Complex Arrangement, Caselets, Assumptions, Premises, Conclusions etc.
- **Quantitative Ability & Data Interpretation:** Arithmetic, Geometry, Mensuration, Percentage, Surds and Indices, Algebra, Mensuration, Bar Diagrams, Pie Charts, Tables, Data Interpretation, etc.

“The VA&LR section will encompass critical & analytical reasoning, reading comprehensions (including poems & passages), vocabulary, basic English grammar, and other related exercises such as para jumbles and cloze tests.”

X. XAT Syllabus 2026 for Decision Making (DM) Section

Decision Making (DM) is a unique section in XAT exam. It tests your ability to holistically view a situation and propose a solution to a problem. DM also tests you on your ethical standing. Check how XLRI defines syllabus for this section, and type of questions that have appeared in past XAT exams.

XAT Official Syllabus for Decision Making

“The DM section will present scenarios drawn from both personal and professional lives. Candidates will be required to apply critical thinking, problem-solving skills, and prioritization to make informed decisions”

XAT 2025 Decision Making Section: Type of Questions

This section consisted of 21 questions. The section consisted of 7 sets of 3 questions each. Some questions were ambiguity with no clear “correct answer”. XAT 2024 DM Section break up is also given below.

While XAT DM section does not have any specific syllabus, based on past papers, this can be considered as XAT DM syllabus.

- Analytical Reasoning Decision Making
- HR related Decision Making
- Ethical Issues Decision Making
- Mixed Issues related to above dimensions

a) Analytical Reasoning Decision Making: Focuses on evaluating and interpreting data, identifying patterns, and solving logical dilemmas.

Key Topics:

- Logical consistency and argument evaluation



- Cause and effect relationships
- Dilemma-based scenarios
- Prioritization and sequencing tasks
- Data sufficiency and interpretation
- Evaluating multiple options under constraints

Example: Choosing the best strategy for product pricing based on market data.

b) HR-Related Decision Making: Tests understanding of organizational behavior, employee management, and workplace dynamics.

Key Topics:

- Recruitment and selection dilemmas
- Performance evaluation and appraisal
- Promotions and internal conflicts
- Conflict resolution in teams
- Workplace policy decisions
- Handling diversity and inclusion

Example: Deciding whether to promote a high-performing but controversial employee.

c) Ethical Issues Decision Making: Assesses ability to make morally sound choices in ambiguous or high-stakes situations.

Key Topics:

- Ethics vs. profitability
- Confidentiality and transparency
- Conflict of interest
- Corporate social responsibility
- Fair treatment and justice
- Whistleblowing scenarios

Example: Choosing between reporting a colleague's misconduct vs. team loyalty.



d) Mixed Issues (Analytical + HR + Ethical): These scenarios combine multiple dimensions, requiring integrated thinking and balanced judgment.

Key Topics:

- Navigating conflicts that involve HR, ethics, and logic
- Trade-offs between ethical integrity and business goals
- Multifaceted problems with both qualitative and quantitative aspects
- Situational judgment with limited information

Example: A team lead must balance employee morale, project deadline, and compliance with a new corporate directive.

X. XAT 2026 for Quantitative Ability & Data Interpretation (QADI)

Quantitative Ability & Data Interpretation (QADI) section has high (28%) weight in XAT exam. QADI questions in XAT are designed to assess the quantitative aptitude of candidates. Check how XLRI officially defines syllabus for this section, and type of questions that have appeared in past exams.

XAT Official Syllabus for Quantitative Ability & Data Interpretation

“The questions in the QA section are primarily formulated around 10th standard Mathematics. Notably, the emphasis is on application-oriented problems. The questions on DI are about clear interpretation, summarization and insightful analysis of the data.”

XAT 2025 Quantitative Ability & Data Interpretation Section: Type of Questions & Difficulty Level

In XAT 2025 exam, out of the 28 questions in the section, 16 questions were on Quantitative Ability and 12 questions were on Data Interpretation. In Quantitative Ability section there were questions from Arithmetic, Geometry, Modern maths, Algebra and Numbers. Check break up below. There were four sets of Data Interpretation with 3 questions in each set.

X. XAT Syllabus 2026 for General Knowledge (GK) Section

The General Knowledge section in XAT exam has 20 questions. Out of this, 12 questions are on current affairs and 8 questions are from static GK. This mix allows for a balanced evaluation of candidates' awareness of both ongoing events and foundational knowledge. It is important to note that scores from the General Knowledge section are not considered while calculating the XAT percentile. However, XLRI Jamshedpur uses GK scores during its final selection process. Check type of questions that have appeared in past exams.
