CMAT 2026 Exam Analysis (Live): CMAT 2026 exam is over. CMAT exam was held today, January 25, 2026 in single shift from 9.00 AM to 12.00 PM. Slight delay is reported in some CMAT exam centre where the exam started at 9.30 AM due to technical reasons. CMAT analysis 2026, published below, covers **Exam Pattern, Section-wise Topics, Type of Questions and Difficulty Level, and CMAT Score Vs Percentile 2026**. There was no major change in CMAT 2026 exam pattern, type of questions and difficulty level. Of the 20 questions in the QTDI section, **17 questions were on Quantitative Technique and only 3 were on Data Interpretation**. The questions were dominated by **Arithmetic questions**. In Logical Reasoning section, **16 questions were on Non-Verbal Reasoning**, and just 4 questions were on Verbal Reasoning. In Language Comprehension Section, there were **18 Non-RC questions and just 2 Reading Comprehension questions**. Out of the 20 General Awareness questions, **almost all were based on Indian Static GK**. In Business and Entrepreneurship paper had questions on concepts like Atal Innovation Mission, **Startup Valuation, Entrepreneur, Angel Investing, Copyright etc**. CMAT Exam Analysis 2026: Exam Pattern

There was no major change in CMAT 2026 exam pattern, type of questions and difficulty level. Check type of questions:

- **Quantitative Techniques and Data Interpretation:** In CMAT 2026, out of 20 questions in the QTDI section, **17 questions were on Quantitative Technique and only 3 were on Data Interpretation.** The questions on Quants were dominated by **Arithmetic** questions.
- **Logical Reasoning:** In Logical Reasoning section, **16 questions were on Non-Verbal Reasoning**, and just 4 questions were on Verbal Reasoning.
- **Language Comprehension:** In Language Comprehension Section, there were **18 non-RC questions and just 2 Reading Comprehension questions.**
- **General Awareness:** Out of the 20 General Awareness questions, almost **all 20 questions were based on Indian Static GK.**
- **Innovation and Entrepreneurship:** This section had questions on concepts like bootstrapping, venture capital, factors impacting markets, qualities of entrepreneurs, ambidexterity theory, design thinking.

X. CMAT 2026 Analysis: Quantitative Technique and Data Interpretation Section

CMAT 2026 Quantitative Technique and Data Interpretation section was of easy difficulty level. Out of 20 questions in the section, 3 questions were on Data Interpretation and the remaining 17 were on Quantitative Technique. There was a set of 3 questions on Data Interpretation which consisted of questions based on a Table which involved simple calculations. As expected, the questions on Quantitative Techniques were dominated by questions on Arithmetic. Out of 17 questions on Quantitative Techniques, 7 questions were on Arithmetic, which included questions on Time and work, Ratio-Proportion, Profit & Loss, Percentages, Allegations and Mixtures and Clocks. There were 6 questions on Numbers. There were 3 questions on Geometry, 1 question on Modern Math zero questions on Algebra. Most of the questions on Quantitative Technique were relatively easy.

X. CMAT 2026 Analysis: Logical Reasoning Section

CMAT 2026 Logical Reasoning section was of easy difficulty level. Similar to last year's pattern, out of the 20 questions in this section, 16 were on Non-Verbal Reasoning and 4 questions were on Verbal Reasoning. All the questions were standalone questions and there were no set-based questions.

The questions on Non-Verbal Reasoning were spread across different topics in Logical

Reasoning such as Family tree, Directions, Cubes, Counting figures, Linear Arrangements, coding and clocks etc. The questions on Verbal Reasoning included questions such as Assertion Reason, Strong/Weak Arguments, Syllogisms, Analogy. The questions were not lengthy and many questions were straightforward and easy to solve. Check detailed breakup of questions in the table below.

X. CMAT 2026 Analysis: Language Comprehension Section

CMAT 2026 Language Comprehension section was of easy to medium difficulty level. The Language Comprehension Section consisted of 2 Reading Comprehension questions and 18 Non-RC questions. The passage was easy to read. The non-RC questions were largely easy as well with one or two moderate questions. The non RC questions were dominated by grammar topics such as prepositions, verb forms, compound sentences, in familiar question types like identifying the correct/incorrect sentence, sentence completion, assertion reason, etc.

X. CMAT 2026 Analysis: General Awareness Section

CMAT 2026 General Awareness section was of medium difficulty level. Out of the 20 General Awareness questions, 19 were based on Static GK, with only 1 question was on current affairs. The majority of questions were based on Indian news and events. Only a few questions were on international developments and events. The questions were on science, sports, books, famous personalities, institutions, history, among others.

CMAT 2026 Innovation and Entrepreneurship Section was of easy to moderate difficulty level. Out of the 20 questions, 17 were based on Business and Entrepreneurship concepts like bootstrapping, venture capital, factors impacting markets, qualities of entrepreneurs, ambidexterity theory, design thinking. 3 questions were on Business GK.

CMAT 2025 Exam Analysis

To understand past patterns and type of questions, read complete CMAT 2025 exam analysis below.

CMAT 2025 was conducted on January 25, 2025, in two slots: The first slot was held between 9 AM to 12 Noon (Slot 1) and the second slot between 2.30 PM to 5.30 PM (Slot 2). There were no major changes in the CMAT 2025 exam pattern. It had a total of 100 questions spread across 5 sections for 400 marks. The test had no sectional timing. Incorrect responses invited negative marks (-1) for each incorrect response

CMAT 2025 slot 1 analysis: Overview

Overall, the difficulty level of slot 1 of CMAT 2025 exam was similar to that of previous year CMAT 2024. Estimates of good attempts and difficulty level is follows:

CMAT 2025 Sectional Analysis: Quantitative Technique and Data Interpretation

This section was relatively easy in terms of Level of Difficulty. Out of 20 questions in the section, 3 were on Data Interpretation and the remaining 17 were on Quantitative Technique. A set of 3 questions on Data Interpretation consisted of questions based on pie charts. These questions on Data Interpretation involved simple calculations.

The questions on Quantitative Techniques were dominated by questions on Arithmetic. Out of 17 questions on Quantitative Techniques, 10 questions were on Arithmetic, which included questions on Time-speed-distance, Ratio-Proportion, Profit & Loss, SICI, Allegations and Mixtures. There were 2 questions each of Modern Math, Numbers and Algebra, 1 question on Geometry. Most of the questions on Quantitative Technique were easy. Some questions involved True-False statements.

CMAT 2025 Sectional Analysis: Logical Reasoning

Out of the 20 questions in this section, 16 were on Non-Verbal Reasoning and 4 questions were on Verbal Reasoning. All the questions were standalone questions and there were no set based questions.

The questions on Non-Verbal Reasoning were spread across different topics in Logical Reasoning such as Directions, Cubes, Counting the number of squares, Linear Arrangements, Family tree and clocks etc. The questions on Verbal Reasoning included questions such as Assertion Reason, Strong/Weak Argument, Assumption, and Conclusion. The questions were not lengthy and many questions were straightforward and very easy to solve.

The Language Comprehension Section consisted of 2 Reading Comprehension questions and 18 Non-RC questions. The passage was easy to read. The non-RC questions were easy as well.

CMAT 2025 Sectional Analysis: General Awareness

Out of the 20 General Awareness questions, all 20 were based on Static GK. The majority of questions were based on Indian events. Only a few questions were on international events. The questions were on science, sports, Indian constitution, history, India and its culture, among others. Overall, this section was of medium difficulty level.

CMAT 2025 Sectional Analysis: Innovation and Entrepreneurship

Out of the 20 questions, 19 were based on Business and Entrepreneurship concepts (Bootstrapping, Startup valuation, Fabian entrepreneur, Angel investment, Lean startup, Trademark, Feasibility analysis). 1 question was on Business GK. Overall, this section was of medium difficulty level.
