### Karnataka PGCET Syllabus 2026

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Karnataka PGCET exam syllabus is divided into five sections as mentioned above. The Karnataka MBA PGCET 2026 exam syllabus covers all the important topics related to each section. Check details below.

### **a) Karnataka PGCET Syllabus 2026 for Proficiency in English Language**

This section tests candidates' understanding of English grammar, vocabulary, and sentence structure. It evaluates the ability to identify and correct errors and improve language usage. Key Topics are given below.

- Grammar and Error Correction: Verb, Noun, Pronoun, Adjective, Adverb, Parts of Speech
- Sentence Structure: Conditional sentences, Time clauses, Reported speech, Passive voice
- Vocabulary: Antonyms, Synonyms, One-word substitution, Idioms/Phrases
- Reading and Completion: Fill in the blanks, Sentence sequencing

### **b) Karnataka PGCET Syllabus 2026 for General Knowledge**

This section assesses candidates' awareness of current events, business, and general knowledge. It covers national and international developments, along with economic and constitutional knowledge. Key Topics are given below.

- Static GK: Constitutional knowledge, States of India, International organizations (UNO, WHO)
- Current Affairs: National and international events, Business and economic news
- Business & Economics: Fiscal and monetary policy, Repo rate, CRR, Devaluation of rupee
- Identification: Personalities, Companies, Emblems, Currencies, Capitals

### **c) Karnataka PGCET Syllabus 2026 for Reasoning and General Intelligence**

This section tests logical thinking, analytical skills, and decision-making ability. It includes various types of reasoning and puzzle-based questions. Key Topics are given below.

- Logical Reasoning: Fact-Inference-Judgment, Statement-Argument, Assumption, Conclusion
- Puzzles and Patterns: Seating arrangement, Blood relations, Series, Binary logic
- Decision Making: Direction sense, Clocks, Calendars, Input-Output
- Critical Thinking: Analogies, Syllogisms, Network diagrams, Matrix arrangements

#### **d) Karnataka PGCET Syllabus 2026 for Quantitative Analysis**

This section evaluates mathematical skills and the ability to interpret and analyze data. It covers fundamental mathematical concepts and data analysis. Key Topics are given below.

- Arithmetic: Percentages, Profit and Loss, Ratios, Interest, Time and Work
- Algebra and Geometry: Permutation and Combination, Coordinate Geometry, Trigonometry
- Data Interpretation: Bar diagrams, Line graphs, Pie charts, Caselets, Data sufficiency
- Statistics: Mean, Median, Deviation, Probability, Venn diagrams

#### **e) Karnataka PGCET Syllabus 2026 for Computer Awareness**

- **Computer Basics:** organization of a computer, central Processing Unit (CPU), Input /output devices, Computer Memory, Programming Languages, Types of Operating Systems, General awareness about Internet. Web Applications, Database Applications and Information systems.
- **Data Representation:** Representation of Characters, Integers and Fractions, Binary, ASCII and Hexadecimal representations.
- **Binary Arithmetic:** Addition, subtraction, Multiplication, Division, Two's complement arithmetic, Floating-point representation of numbers, normalized Floating-point representation.
- **Operating systems:** Evolution of operating systems, types of operating systems, functions of an operating system, modern operating systems.
