### ATMA Exam Eligibility Criteria 2026

[ATMA exam eligibility](#) prescribes that a graduate from any recognized/statutory University with a minimum of 50% marks can apply and appear in ATMA Exam. Those who are in their final year of graduation, are also eligible to apply and appear in the ATMA exam.

## ATMA Registration 2026

[ATMA registration 2026](#) is open. ATMA registration fees 2026 is Rs 2000. Check how to fill ATMA registration form. ATMA 2026 registration process can be divided into following simple steps:

- **STEP 1 - PAYMENT OF FEES:** Candidate must use his/her personal mobile number and Email ID ONLY. The registration process for ATMA Exam starts with the Payment of Fees. The Registration Fee for ATMA exam is of Rs 2000.
- **STEP 2 - PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION NO. (PID):** Once the fee is paid, the candidate will receive a system generated Personal Identification Number (PID) on his/her Mobile by SMS as well as Email.
- **STEP 3 - FILLING REGISTRATION FORM:** Once the payment of Fee is successful and the PID is received, the candidate can proceed to fill the registration form. Every candidate shall be given a login password once the registration process is complete.
- **STEP 4 - PRINTING ADMIT CARD:** Once the registration is complete, candidate can proceed for Printing of Admit Card after the given date.

Inference, Blood Relations/Family Tree, Circular Arrangement, Strong/Weak Arguments, Analogy.

### **Section 2: Verbal Skills**

Reading Comprehension, Grammar, Synonyms and Antonyms, Jumbled Sentences, Vocabulary/Word Meaning, Sentence Completion

### **Section 3: Quantitative Skills**

Profit, Loss and Discount, Number System, Speed- Time and Distance, Algebra, Modern Maths, Quadratic Equation, Geometry, LCM and HCF, Average, Permutation and Combination, Ratio and Proportion, Mensuration, Logarithm, Binomial Theorem, Percentage
