XAT 2027 Exam Pattern

To understand XAT syllabus, first you should know the exam pattern. [XAT 2027 exam pattern](#) is divided into two parts. XAT exam Part 1 consists of 75 questions to be solved in 170 minutes. This part consists of following sections: Decision Making (21 questions), Verbal and Logical Ability (26 questions), Quantitative Ability and Data Interpretation (28 questions). XAT exam Part 2 consists of 20 questions on General Knowledge (GK) to be solved in 10 minutes. Note that XAT GK section marks are not considered when calculating

the XAT percentile, and used only for XLRI Jamshedpur admission process. Check details in table below.

“The VA&LR section will encompass critical & analytical reasoning, reading comprehensions (including poems & passages), vocabulary, basic English grammar, and other related exercises such as para jumbles and cloze tests.”

XAT Verbal Ability & Logical Reasoning: Type of Questions

In XAT 2026 VA LR section, there were 15 Reading Comprehension questions, 2 poem-based questions and 9 Verbal Ability/Reasoning questions. The Verbal Ability/Verbal Reasoning questions were based on grammar, vocabulary, and reasoning-based questions. The five passages were of 300 – 550 words each approximately. Many of the questions in XAT VALR 2026 exam were inferential and application-based. Check more details in the table below.

XAT 2027 Syllabus for Decision Making (DM) Section

XAT Decision Making Syllabus 2027: Decision Making (DM) is a unique section in XAT exam. It tests your ability to holistically view a situation and propose a solution to a problem. DM also tests you on your ethical standing. Check how XLRI defines syllabus for this section, XAT exam syllabus and type of questions that have appeared in past XAT exams below.

XAT Official Syllabus for Decision Making

“The DM section will present scenarios drawn from both personal and professional lives. Candidates will be required to apply critical thinking, problem-solving skills, and prioritization to make informed decisions”

While XAT DM section does not have any specific syllabus, based on previous years' papers, XAT DM syllabus 2027 can be divided into four areas: Analytical Reasoning Decision Making, HR related Decision Making, Ethical Issues Decision Making and Mixed Questions. Check detailed topics for each area below.

a) Analytical Reasoning Decision Making: Focuses on evaluating and interpreting data, identifying patterns, and solving logical dilemmas.

Key Topics:

- Logical consistency and argument evaluation
- Cause and effect relationships
- Dilemma-based scenarios
- Prioritization and sequencing tasks
- Data sufficiency and interpretation
- Evaluating multiple options under constraints
- Example: Choosing the best strategy for product pricing based on market data.

b) HR-Related Decision Making: Tests understanding of organizational behavior, employee management, and workplace dynamics.

Key Topics:

- Recruitment and selection dilemmas
- Performance evaluation and appraisal

- Promotions and internal conflicts
- Conflict resolution in teams
- Workplace policy decisions
- Handling diversity and inclusion
- Example: Deciding whether to promote a high-performing but controversial employee.

c) Ethical Issues Decision Making: Assesses ability to make morally sound choices in ambiguous or high-stakes situations.

Key Topics:

- Ethics vs. profitability
- Confidentiality and transparency
- Conflict of interest
- Corporate social responsibility
- Fair treatment and justice
- Whistleblowing scenarios

Example: Choosing between reporting a colleague’s misconduct vs. team loyalty.

d) Mixed Issues (Analytical + HR + Ethical): These scenarios combine multiple dimensions, requiring integrated thinking and balanced judgment.

Key Topics:

- Navigating conflicts that involve HR, ethics, and logic
- Trade-offs between ethical integrity and business goals
- Multifaceted problems with both qualitative and quantitative aspects
- Situational judgment with limited information

Example: A team lead must balance employee morale, project deadline, and compliance with a new corporate directive.

XAT QADI Syllabus 2027: Quantitative Ability & Data Interpretation (QADI) section has high (28%) weight in XAT exam. QADI questions in XAT are designed to assess the quantitative aptitude of candidates. “The questions in the QA section are primarily formulated around 10th standard Mathematics. Notably, the emphasis is on application-oriented problems. The questions on DI are about clear interpretation, summarization and insightful analysis of the data.”

XAT Syllabus for Quantitative Aptitude Section: To do well in this section, you should have a foundational understanding of arithmetic, algebra, geometry, mensuration, modern maths. Check XAT QT section syllabus below.
