IBSAT 2026 Preparation Framework: A Three-Phase Approach

- Revise grammar fundamentals: subject-verb agreement, tenses, articles, prepositions, parallelism. Use *Wren & Martin* or *Norman Lewis*
- Practice 5 analogies, 5 synonyms, 5 antonyms daily

Reading Comprehension (30 questions)

- Read one editorial daily from *The Hindu*, *Mint*, *Business Standard*, or *The Economist*

- Read one long-form article weekly from *Aeon*, *The Atlantic*, or *Harvard Business Review*
- Solve 1 RC passage every alternate day from any standard MBA prep book

Quantitative Aptitude (30 questions)

- Revise NCERT Class 8–10 mathematics, particularly Arithmetic and Number Systems
- Master percentages, ratios, profit & loss, simple/compound interest, time-speed-distance, time & work, and mixtures. These are the highest-frequency arithmetic topics in IBSAT
- Build mental math speed using Vedic math techniques

Data Adequacy & Data Interpretation (30 questions)

- Understand the five-option Data Sufficiency answer framework thoroughly. This five-option format is a defining feature of IBSAT among Indian MBA exams
- Solve 5 DS questions daily from any standard MBA prep book
- Begin tabular and pie-chart DI sets

Phase 2: Sectional Practice

This is the most decisive phase. Aspirants who underperform in IBSAT mocks usually do so because they skipped focused sectional practice.

Section-wise practice targets:

- 2 RC passages daily (alternate business / philosophy / science / current affairs topics)
- 1 DI set + 5 Data Sufficiency questions daily
- 20 Quant questions daily, with strict timing of 60–90 seconds per question
