

# KIITEE MBA Syllabus 2027: Section-wise Topics, Weightage & Study Priorities

The **KIITEE MBA Syllabus 2027** is organised around the four sections of the KIITEE Management entrance test: Quantitative Aptitude, Analytical Reasoning, English and General Knowledge. KIIT School of Management (KSOM) officially defines these four sections and their question distribution, and the content is broadly similar to other leading MBA entrance exams. This MBAUniverse.com guide sets out the **KIITEE MBA Syllabus 2027** section by section, with the indicative topics you should prepare, the weightage of each area, and clear study priorities. ## KIITEE MBA Syllabus 2027: Section Overview & Weightage

The KIITEE Management 2027 paper has 120 questions spread across four sections. In KIITEE MBA Syllabus 2027, English carries the highest weightage, followed by Quantitative Aptitude and Analytical Reasoning, with General Knowledge completing the paper. The table below shows how the KIITEE MBA Syllabus 2027 maps to the question distribution.

## KIITEE MBA Syllabus 2027: Quantitative Aptitude

Quantitative Aptitude carries 30 questions and tests your numerical ability, mathematical fundamentals and problem-solving speed. The level of difficulty is manageable for aspirants with clear basics, and this section is a strong scoring area for those who practise regularly. Indicative topics to prepare are:

- Arithmetic — percentages, ratio and proportion, averages, profit and loss, simple and compound interest.
- Number System — factors, multiples, HCF and LCM, divisibility.
- Algebra — linear and quadratic equations, inequalities.

- Geometry and Mensuration — lines, angles, triangles, circles, areas and volumes.
- Time, Speed and Distance; Time and Work.
- Permutation, combination and basic probability.
- Data Interpretation — tables, bar charts, pie charts and line graphs.

Because Quant rewards accuracy and speed, aspirants should focus on mastering formulas and shortcuts, then practise a large volume of questions under timed conditions.

### **KIITEE MBA Syllabus 2027: Analytical Reasoning**

The Analytical Reasoning section also carries 30 questions and assesses logical thinking, pattern recognition and the ability to work through structured puzzles. This section rewards practice more than theory, as familiarity with question types directly improves both speed and accuracy. Indicative topics include:

- Logical reasoning and deductive reasoning.
- Seating arrangements — linear and circular.
- Blood relations and family tree problems.
- Coding-decoding.
- Series — number, letter and mixed series.
- Syllogisms and statement-based reasoning.
- Puzzles, analogy and pattern-based sets.

Solving a wide variety of puzzles and reasoning sets is the most effective way to build the intuition this section demands. Aim to reduce the time spent per set as your accuracy improves.

### **KIITEE MBA Syllabus 2027: English**

English is the largest section in the KIITEE Management 2027 paper, with 40 questions, and therefore deserves the most attention. It tests reading ability, grammar, vocabulary and verbal reasoning. Consistent reading is the single best way to strengthen this section. Indicative topics are:

- Reading Comprehension — passage-based questions.
- Grammar — error spotting and sentence correction.
- Vocabulary — synonyms, antonyms and word usage.
- Para-jumbles and para-completion.
- Fill in the blanks.

- Verbal reasoning and critical reasoning.

Since English carries a third of the paper, a strong performance here can lift your overall score significantly. Reading newspapers, editorials and quality business writing daily builds both comprehension speed and vocabulary.

### **KIITEE MBA Syllabus 2027: General Knowledge**

General Knowledge carries 20 questions and tests your awareness of the world around you — from current affairs to business, economy and static general knowledge. This is a section where preparation is either done or not; you cannot reason your way to an answer on exam day, so consistent reading in the months before the test is essential. Indicative topics include:

- Current affairs — national and international events.
- Business and economy — corporate news, markets and economic developments.
- Science and technology.
- Sports, awards and honours.
- Static general knowledge — geography, history, polity and important personalities.

Aspirants should follow a daily current-affairs habit and periodically revise static general knowledge. This section can be answered quickly, freeing up time for the more calculation-intensive parts of the paper.
